


*Being mentioned in any email, being on any timeline, or being involved with any group is not in itself any indication of guilt or wrong doing. This report is meant to be taken as a whole, and used to examine inconsistencies and possibly make connections not previously apparent. Also, the timeline portion in "Appendix One" is not meant to be "exhaustive". Meaning it is not every meeting by every person. Only meetings that were deemed significant to the timeline of Burisma, Biden, or impeachment.



After the release and analysis of The Biden Laptop by Marco Polo, and additional analysis on bidenlaptopemails.com, discrepancies and omissions were noted in the testimony of Biden advisor, Amos Hochstein. The importance of any possible deception on the part of Mr. Hochstein is even more disturbing, considering his former boss has made him a part of the current administration as Senior Advisor for Energy Security.

While no analysis can conclusively portray all events in context, read the mind of the person giving testimony, or simply explain why certain omissions were possibly made, it is important to note them for further examination. In this case, it would be a massively controversial issue surrounding Joe Biden, Hunter Biden, and both of their actions in Ukraine. The following is a comparison of Amos Hochstein's Senate testimony, to emails recently uncovered by Marco Polo in The Biden Laptop. In addition, multiple layers have been added by integrating WH Visitor logs, press reports, the actions of NGO's and other events as they happened in real time. These all relate to not only the Bidens and Ukraine, but to issues surrounding the 2016 election and the lead up to the 2020 election.


Whatever conclusions are drawn are at this time speculative but it cannot be denied that deserve further examination is necessary.



Early in the testimony of Amos Hochstein, it is noted by Mr. Wittmann that there was an article dated July 8th, 2014 titled, "Ukrainian employer of Joe Biden's son hires a D.C. lobbyist". There is some discussion of that article and Mr. Hochstein becoming aware of Hunter Biden joining the board of Burisma due to that article (or similar press reports).

MR. WITTMANN: At some point, do you remember around
 what time in 2014?
 MR. HOCHSTEIN: It was in the press at some point, and
 I don't remember. I believe it was in the spring, but I
 don't recall. But, you know, I don't recall specifically.
 MR. WITTMANN: So you're saying that you became aware
 of it spring of 2014, because of press articles?
 MR. HOCHSTEIN: Correct. That was how I first learned
 of it.

Mr. Wittmann goes on to note that on July 9th, 2014 that Mr. Hochstein forwards an email to Melanie Nakagawa. It is titled, "FYI, per your email re: David Leiter". Is it because Leiter had already been lobbying for Burisma, and Mr. Hochstein had already been aware of this through personal contact? The interesting part is while the questioning and testimony revolve around Mr. Leiter and the awareness at the State Department of Hunter Biden's position on the board of Burisma, it eventually leaps to the November 6, 2015 meeting with Hunter Biden. This leaves a nearly one and half year gap that never gets fully filled in. The impression Mr. Hochstein gives is that he was made aware of this article, and he simply met Hunter Biden over a year later. Upon closer examination of information not available to the Senate at the time, this does not appear to be correct.



As we now know from the Marco Polo examination of "The Biden Laptop" the below email between Heather King (Attorney at Hunter Biden's legal firm, Boies, Schiller & Flexner LLP) and Vadim Pozharskyi, interesting actions are happening behind the scenes that appear to dive deeper into the circumstances Mr. Hochstein described. As you can see, Mr. Pozaharskyi had been in Washington D.C. having "meetings" and Ms. King is suggesting the full team hold a conference call to discuss further steps. Who was Mr. Pozharskyi meeting with in D.C.? It appears that Mr. Hochstein was likely one of the people who Burisma was in contact with as you will see later. The original email is dated 7/28/14, so the meeting was likely the week prior.

HOCHSTEIN TESTIMONY ANALYSIS 2022



In preparation for this meeting, which Mr. Pozharskyi asks to be postponed in light of developments in Ukraine, we see a variety of things in the following email chain dated 7/31/14:

1: That Mr. Pozharzskyi is not so much concerned with US Policy to Ukraine, but in getting US officials to intervene in Ukrainian policy on the behalf of Burisma. A subtle yet significant detail that Mr. Hochstein never made clear in his Senate testimony.

2: This intervention takes the shape of influencing a package of laws being proposed in Ukraine to lay a heavy tax on private gas producers (this apparently would not affect public gas producers such as Naftogaz).

3: MOST IMPORTANTLY:


a: That Ms. King assumes that Mr. Pozharskyi "will be sending an email to the State Dept about this". Why would Mr. Pozharskyi have direct access to the State Dept (particularly already in July)? Who at the State Dept would he have been contacting directly to discuss Ukrainian domestic energy policy?

b: That Ms. King is going to get Mr. Pozharskyi "connected with the US Embassy" so he can **"hopefully meet with guy HOCHSTEIN RECOMMENDED"**. How long was Hochstein pulling strings for Burisma and Hunter Biden to provide access that regular people would not have? All within 7 to 12 days after he allegedly "first heard Hunter was on the board".

Now according to Mr. Hochstein's Senate testimony there is no mention of him having any communications in July of 2014 between himself and Boies, Schiller & Flexner LLP, nor with Mr. Leiter who is a recipient of this email, nor Hunter Biden, Devon Archer, or Mr. Pozharskyi. The email is clear that Mr. Hochstein "recommended" someone for Burisma. When did Mr. Hochstein "recommend"? Why is he interjecting himself with Burisma and the business dealings of Hunter Biden as early as July of 2014?

This would indicate that Vadim Pozharskyi had a meeting (call or face to face) with Amos Hochstein during the week he was in DC. It appears Pozharskyi was in DC the week of 7/21/14 through 7/28/14 (approximately) according to this email. The email also states Hunter should "not be on that call". Is that because they are trying to shield him from something related to Joe? We can only speculate.




Another interesting finding in the laptop is an email forward from Kathy Chung in the Vice President's Office, titled "FW: Highlights for the week of July 13". This is the week of July 13th, 2014. Just six days after Mr. Hochstein claims to have learned about Hunter Biden and Burisma in the press. He meets briefly with Vice President, Joe Biden. It is an oddly noted meeting, without any time frame attached, but appears to take place between "Meeting with White House Summer Intern Class" and "Depart White House en route Naval Observatory", and appears to have been a very brief 15 minute meeting squeezed in between the two appointments for the VP.


On September 24, 2014 we see in the laptop an exchange, once again, about the private gas producer tax to the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine. Vadim Pozharskyi appears agitated by the fact that their efforts so far have been modestly successful in the short term, but that the legislature is still pushing for other initiatives on the topic. To recipients Heather King, David Leiter, and Devon Archer, he uses such phrases as "...looking forward to your ideas on how we could *influence this process*", and "If enacted, this law would kill the entire private gas production sector..." He finishes this email by saying "I am going to share this information with the *US Embassy here in Kyiv, as well as the office of Mr. Amos Hochstein* in the United States". This email is forwarded to Hunter Biden by Devon Archer.

To circle back, Mr. Hochstein said he first heard about Hunter Biden being involved with Burisma in a news article in July of 2014. Devon and Hunter – The immediate plan is to reach out to the Energy and Ukraine desks, respectively, at State Dept to introduce them to Burisma and "update" them on Burisma's current situation, which will include the issues you've emailed me about today per Vadim's emails to you. We can't just go in there with a hard ask but it is often the case that the conversation is open to an ask, assuming it goes well. That will include outreach to Carlos Pascual, he is the top US energy diplomat; his actual title is Special Envoy and Coordinator for International Energy Affairs at State. He was formerly US Ambassador to Ukraine ('00-03) and later to Mexico (09-12 - he was apparently not so great in Mexico but still respected and highly effective). He was recently in Ukraine and on the Hill briefing the Senate Foreign Relations Committee privately about Ukraine and the challenges it faces.



It should also be noted that while all information in regards to Hunter Biden's role at Burisma was publicized as heading up their legal, and transparency issues, it appears their only interest in him on the board is to use him for his influence and to rely on Heather King at Boies for legal. Nearly all email communications involving Hunter Biden and Vadim Pozharskyi involve utilizing Hunter's contacts, and the contacts of his inner circle for the purpose of improving the situation of Nikolai Zlochevsky, his prosecution in Ukraine, his visas issues, or to influence Ukrainian law to benefit Burisma.

The tax increase on producers was passed and extended for months, finally being repealed in late 2015. It does not appear that US lobbying efforts (if there were any by government officials, were successful at the time of implementation.) It is unclear if any US effort was involved in having the measure revoked, as it was originally billed as a "temporary measure" to begin with.







After a joint forum with the Atlantic Council, a delegation from the United States went to the gas field. Ukraine's largest gas production company Burisma Group has invited an American delegation to its fields in the Kharkiv region. After a forum on Ukrainian-American partnership held on April 17 at the Palace of the Premier Hotel in Kharkiv, with the support of Burisma Group and under the auspices of the Kharkiv Regional State Administration, Burisma Group demonstrated drilling of two ultra-deep wells and technological UKPG. Roman Popadyuk, as well as Evelyn Farkas, former US Deputy Secretary of Defense for Russia, Ukraine and Eurasia, and Morgan Williams, president of the American-Ukrainian Business Council (USUBC). Sources in the publication say that the Americans held talks with the managers of Zlochevsky's companies, promised support and saw for themselves how American equipment works in deposits. This was reported by capital.ua. The arrival of American politicians and the organization of the Kharkiv Forum on Security and Ukrainian-American Partnership took place in cooperation with Burisma Group and the Atlantic Council, an influential American think tank. It will be recalled that in early 2017, Ukraine's largest gas company Burisma Group enlisted the support of the Atlantic Council in the framework of bilateral agreements on cooperation in the field of energy independence and security. The most powerful drilling machine in Ukraine SK3000, which was created and put into operation by the American company Service King, works at the Burisma Group field in Vodyanivka. 
